### Summary of discussions on each topic

All proposals were discussed through a lens of student success with a focus on ensuring that proposed changes would remove barriers to graduation.

Changes to course include: (a) changes to course title, (b) changes to course descriptions, (c) changes to course pre- or co-requisites, (d) change to schedule type, (e), changes to contact hours, (f) changes to course repeatability, (f) changes to CIP code, and other changes.

Changes to programs range from substantive to non-substantive. An example of a substantive change is the revision to the MS in Biology, the revision to the MS in Chemistry, and the revision of the MA in Clinical Psychology. Non-substantive changes typically include adding or removing prescribed electives or removing untaught courses.

Deleted programs at the graduate level are sometimes the result of a program name change rather than a true discontinued program. When this occurs, a "deleted" program is replaced with a "new" program. This mirrors the external approval process. For example, the Board-Certified Behavior Analyst Certificate was renamed to the Applied Behavior Analysis Certificate.

Deleted programs at the graduate level also include programs being discontinued. Examples of programs being discontinued include the UXUI Certificate, the MSN Nursing Education, and the MSN Nursing



Administration. These programs are being deleted due to low enrollment and/or changes in future direction of the discipline.

New programs were introduced in the College of P-16 Integration (CEP) and College of Business and Entrepreneurship (COBE). The programs approved for the CEP provide a path to initial teacher certification at the graduate level or post-master's certification as an educational diagnostician. COBE introduced the MS in Marketing. These programs will need external approval.

In addition to the changes described above, the following policies were revised and approved by the Graduate Committee. The changes are non-substantive.
