Message from the Dean

Season's Greetings from the RGV!

As 2022 comes to a close, we have many achievements to celebrate in RCVCOBE this year. We began the year with a scheduled peer review team visit as part of our five-year maintenance of Association to Advance Colleges and Schools of Business (AACSB) accreditation. The college received many laudatory remarks from the team for the

college's commitment to its mission and extraordinary progress in its research enterprise as maintenance of accreditation was secured. That commitment to our mission was recognized on multiple fronts as the RCVCOBE family showed its resilience during the challenges of the pandemic. The student organization ENACTUS was recognized by AACSB as one of 24 global business schools with **Innovations the Inspire** in diversity, inclusion, equity and belonging efforts. Those efforts in the college were further strengthened by the new Kemper Scholars program launched this year. Dr. Giorgio Gotti, Director of the School of Accountancy, received the Outstanding Accounting Educator Award for the State of Texas. The success of our students continues to be at the center of our mission.

And as our peer review team noted, the research productivity continues to grow at a rapid pace as faculty scholars make their mark as subject matter experts in their fields. Among them being Dr. Hale Kaynak who was recognized by Stanford University for being in the top 2% of cited scholars in her field. And the citations for many faculty members in the college continues to climb as more elite and high impact journal articles are published. The SCOPUS citation count for RCVCOBE faculty has already topped 5,500 this year with a few days to go. That count was under 3,000 three years ago. To almost double the citation impact of a college in three years is a rare feat. And the faculty want to extend their impact to our undergraduate students with a

new undergraduate research program. This also fulfills our primary mission of placing our students and their success as our primary goal. Whether academic scholars or merely scholars in life, our graduates will possess the critical skills to evaluate problems they encounter in a scientific manner.

These achievements are made possible by the sense of teamwork and commitment of the RCVCOBE family. A dean could not be more proud of how this family has come together to serve our mission and generate positive social impact. Here is to celebrating the success of 2022 and looking forward to many more in 2023.


What's more impressive is that some of the publications are in the **Financial Times (FT) Top 50** journals such as *Journal of the Academy of Marketing Science, Journal of Corporate Finance*, and *Journal of Business Ethics*. Additionally, faculty and doctoral students had **29 papers accepted for presentation in top academic conferences** such as the American Accounting Association (AAA), Academy of Management (AOM), American Marketing Association (AMA), and American Finance Association (AFA), among others.

The scholarly impact of our faculty continues to trend upward as evidenced by

growing SCOPUS citations (157 for 2022, and more than 1700 since the pandemic began in 2020).

Outstanding Student Engagement

2022 was another successful year when it comes to student engagement. RCVCOBE students, undergraduate and graduate alike, have been actively involved in their student organizations and professional associations. In Spring 2022, three of our students in Accountancy and Finance were selected for the inaugural **Kemper Scholars program**. With this program, the Kemper foundation provides scholarships to high-performing students in minority-serving institutions such as UTRGV. An Undergraduate Research Program was Launched in Fall 2022

The Vackar Student Scholars (VSS) program is an undergraduate research initiative at the Robert C. Vackar College of Business & Entrepreneurship (RCVCOBE). It is designed to provide eligible



RCVCOBE's undergraduate students with an opportunity to conduct research projects in collaboration with faculty mentors.

Eleven students were selected to participate in this program this fall and will work with their faculty mentor on a research project during fall and spring semesters. The program concludes with a presentation of their findings in the spring semester. In addition to learning about research, selected students will also learn about our PhD program and possible career opportunities in academia.
