
Course description: 8D methodology is a philosophy and a part of continuous improvement; it is a problem solving methodology. The process is clear, easy to follow and is documented in different forms.

 - 5 Why technique

 - Difference and Change Analysis
 - Fishbone/Cause and Effects
 - Active and Passive Verification

- D4 Interim Corrective Action
- D5 Root Cause Analysis & Escape Point
- D6 Corrective Action / Permanent Corrective Actions and Validations
- D7 Prevent Recurrence
- D8 Eight Disciplines as Communication & Team Recognition
