

8D Methodology

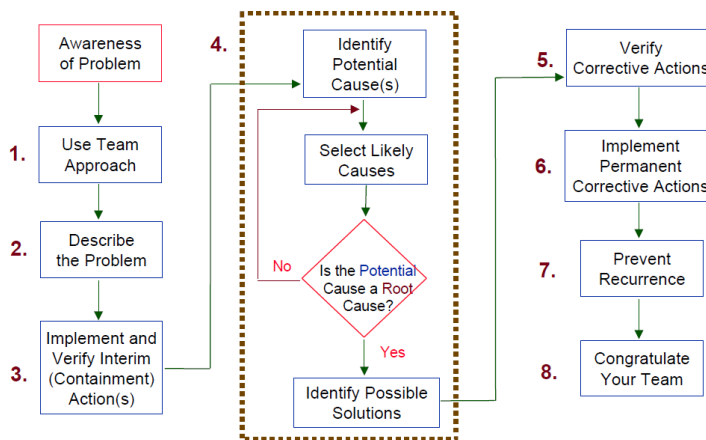
Course description: 8D methodology is a philosophy and a part of continuous improvement; it is a problem solving methodology. The process is clear, easy to follow and is documented in different forms.

- D0 – Should we do this?
- D1 - Establishing a Team
- D3 - Problem Definition and Root Cause Analysis.
 - Problem Statement (What is wrong with what?)
 - 5 Why technique
 - Is and Is Not
 - Difference and Change Analysis
 - Fishbone/Cause and Effects
 - Active and Passive Verification

- D4 - Interim Corrective Action
- D5 - Root Cause Analysis & Escape Point
- D6 - Corrective Action / Permanent Corrective Actions and Validations
- D7 - Prevent Recurrence
- D8 - Eight Disciplines as Communication & Team Recognition
 - *(Hands-on workshop- exercise is carried through the different steps)*
